TDA format in organising impact

“Impact before – during – after”

- Strategic policy, select joint topics/needs. Careful selection of participants in various schools.
- Preparation meeting: present yourself, pitch your individual learning goals in English and introduce your school.
- Shared responsibility: participants have a task in presenting the group and objectives to the host of that day. Making report of the day. Etc.
- Each evening short group evaluation.
- Individual evaluation reports, disseminating new ideas/outcomes to the own organisation, organise a seminar for all TDA schools.
